Overview

The Managed Care Pharmacy Internship is a two-year paid internship within the Managed Pharmacy Solutions team at UNC Health. Interns will gain experience in the managed care areas of population health/ambulatory care, pharmacy benefits management, clinical program development, research health outcomes, and analytics. The internship is primarily project-based and allows students to explore various aspects of managed care pharmacy. Our program has four interns – two PY2s and two PY3s.
