

UNC HEALTH VOLUNTEER VACCINE CHECKLIST

All UNC Health volunteers are required to have documented immunity to the following diseases in the following ways:

Influenza

VACCINE: Must provide official documentation of vaccination for the current flu season (Sept-April/May).

Measles, Mumps, and Rubella One (1) of the options below:

1. **VACCINE:** Must provide official documentation of 2 MMR vaccines. ---OR--- HCP must provide documentation of individual vaccines totaling 2 Measles, 2 Mumps, and 1 Rubella vaccinations.
 2. **TITER:** Must provide official documentation of positive laboratory titers.
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Tuberculosis Screening

TESTING: Must provide record of 2 tuberculin skin tests performed within a 12-month period (2-step skin test). If 2-step test was performed greater than 12 months ago, an annual screening must be completed. An IGRA performed within the last 12 months will be accepted as documentation for TB testing. (If history of positive TST or IGRA, then official documentation of a chest x-ray within the past 2 years with official interpretation by a radiologist should be provided. Please also provide any documentation of latent tuberculosis treatment. (The 2-step test requires 4 visits to your health provider.) The 2nd TB test can be placed one week after the 1st one has been read.

Varicella (Chicken Pox) One (1) of the options below:

1. **VACCINE:** Must provide official documentation of 2 Varicella (chicken pox) vaccines or 1 Zostavax vaccine (shingles) or 2 Shingrix vaccine (shingles).
 2. **TITER:** Must provide official documentation of positive laboratory titer.
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COVID

VACCINE: Must provide official documentation of completed vaccination.

Pertussis

VACCINE: Must provide vaccine record of one TDAP as an adult or adolescent (≥ 11 years of age).

Hepatitis B- Optional One (1) of the options below:

1. **VACCINE:** Must provide official documentation of vaccination. Should have a total of 3 vaccines to complete one series of Hepatitis B vaccines.
 2. **TITER:** A positive laboratory titer is accepted as proof of immunity.
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*Hepatitis B vaccination is not required, but highly recommended, for those who volunteer in an area that have potential for blood or body fluid exposure (Douglas, Cuddlers, ED). If you are unsure if your placement falls into one of these categories, please contact Volunteer Services or Occupational Health for clarification.
