

## Use of POCT Devices in Research

Research studies using point-of-care testing (POC) may need to be reviewed by the UNCH Point-of-Care Testing Committee when the POC testing results are used to screen for inclusion, monitoring or treatment (for example, in the decision to administer a drug or conduct imaging studies). Examples of such tests include, but are not limited to, urine pregnancy testing, glucose monitoring, coagulation testing, etc. The POC committee assures the devices used are appropriate and testing complies with CAP/JCAHO regulations.
