PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

The Specialty Pharmacy Administration & Leadership (SPAL) Internship is a two-year program providing experience at the UNC Specialty and Home Delivery Pharmacy in Morrisville, NC. The student intern will be exposed to and involved in projects relating to specialty pharmacy workflow, accreditation, and clinical patient management. The intern will also engage in a longitudinal project with the goal of presenting a poster at a conference.

There are a multitude of leadership/administrative opportunities for the student intern to explore, including:

- staffing in a specialty pharmacy
- gaining hands on experience with rare and specialty disease state management
- leading projects related to workflows and compliance
- shadowing opportunities related to the intern's interests
- gaining experience with medication access and the UNC Pharmacy Assistance Program (PAP)
